No-Sew DIY Fringed Scarf Tutorial for American Girl Dolls by Clarisse's Closet


What you'll need:
14 " x 14" Square of lightweight cotton fabric
*A very lightweight fabric will work best- your standard quilting cotton is a little too heavy and won't drape as well around the neck.
*Be sure to cut the square along the grainline (meaning straight along the woven threads) not diagonally.


Using your thumb nail and your pointer finger, scrape out the first few threads of the fabric along the center of one side.


Continue to pull the threads along the side, until they come free from the fabric.


Tip:
If the thread bunches up the fabric as you pull and breaks, just smooth the fabric back out and continue pulling where the threads broke off.


Continue Removing the theads until there is about a $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ of fringe (or desired length). Repeat along each edge, and you're finished!
